Mountain States Hospital where she worked for more than 42 years. For anyone who knew her Peachie couldn't sit still. She was constantly cleaning and singing. If you were a guest in her home or anywhere for that matter and you were family, she was serving you. She was always concerned about those around her.

Peachie loved to cook for the family. She could take a few dollars and turn it into a feast. She would always offer you cook you something to eat. She couldn't stand the thought that someone was hungry. She would offer to pull the entire refrigerator out for a mid-day snack. You definitely couldn't lose weight around Peachie.

Peachie would get a garden hoe out of the shed and weed the entire flower beds and gardens one weed at a time. She would say, "I don't have much but I take good care of what I do have". She would take it upon herself to buy paint and brushes and touch up things once they couldn't be cleaned anymore. If she ran out of things to do she would come and clean for you.

If you've ever met an angel on earth Peachie was it. Anyone who encountered her would say no different.

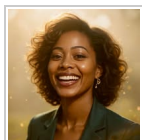

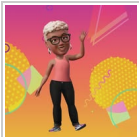
