Robert Lynn Kyle, “Bobby”, 76, passed away January 23, 2025, at the James H. Quillen Veterans Medical Center, Johnson City, TN. Robert was born November 19, 1948, to the late Robert E. Kyle and Anna Mae Isom Kyle. He accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of Lawrence United Presbyterian Church.

Robert resided in Morristown and is survived by his loving, devoted wife, Bettie Long Kyle of 57 years. Leaving to cherish his memories are his brother Glenn Kyle, Johnson City, his sister Linda McDermott, Morristown, her twin sister Brenda (Lorenzo) Wyatt, Knoxville, and Uncle William “Bill” Isom, Morristown.
